All staff require Safeguarding Adult training every 3 years.

All CCG Staff also require PREVENT training, every 3 years.

GPs and Practice Nurses require 3 hours safeguarding adult training annually (totalling a minimum of 8 hours over 3 years) in a related subject, including the following:-

- Safeguarding Adults (Level 3) – Mandatory every 3 years
- PREVENT
- Mental Capacity Act/Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards
- Domestic Abuse Awareness
- Multi Agency Risk Conference (MARAC)
- FGM
- Modern Slavery
- Financial Abuse
- Multi Agency Public Protection Arrangements (MAPPA)
- Safeguarding Conferences
- Hate Crime
- Making Enquiries under S42 Training
- Chairing Multi Agency Meetings

****Mental Capacity App****

The Mental Capacity Act and Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards are an important part of all patients/lives. While the act tells us we must always assume a person has capacity, there will be times in our clinical assessment of a patient where capacity may be in doubt in relation to a specific decision. It is appropriate to carry out capacity assessment. On those occasions the MCA App can help you to make this assessment by simply following the pathway and answering the question yes or no.
